

Pine River Library Program in a Bag: DIY Paper Succulents



**Making your own unique paper succulents is super easy!
Just follow these simple steps for each pattern.**

1. Place the pattern on top of a piece of the green paper.
2. Cut out all the shapes.
3. Use something to curl the edges of the leaves upward- a credit card works great. You can also use your fingers. Curl all leaves in the same direction.
4. Starting with the biggest cutout, glue each of the layers together with a dab of glue in the center the cutout. Tacky glue works best, but plain Elmers, a glue gun, or even a glue stick would be fine too. Make sure to offset the petals of each layer.
5. At this point you can emphasize the curls or folds more with your fingers to get a truly unique look.
