Materials:

- 2 paper bags*
- Colorful construction paper*
- Pen/pencil/marker/colored pencils
- Tape
- Scissors

- 2. Let them draw, cut out, and tape as much as possible.
- 3. Then play away, making sure to give space for back and forth conversation.
