

JULY 7TH: INSECTS! STORYTIME SONGS & CRAFTS



CRAFT: EMOTIONAL LADYBUG

- Materials you will need:
 - Red & black paper*
 - 2 googly eyes*
 - 1 piece of pipe cleaner* (cut in half then take 1 inch off each half, longer half are the antennae and the shorter pieces are for attaching the wings.)
 - Feelings wheel*
 - Scissors & glue
- Items with an * are provided to take home if you do not want to stay and do the craft at the library.

Directions

- 1. Body and spots:
 - a. Cut an 8 or 9 inch circle out of black paper- you can use a paper plate to measure.
 - b. Use the remaining black paper to cut our smaller black circles for the head AND to make spots for your ladybug. The black circles should be a little larger than a quarter. Around 8 is a good number to cut out.

2. Head:

- a. Glue eyes on at one end of the smaller round black circle.
- b. Attach the antennae (long half of the pipe cleaner) and attach above the eyes.

3. Wings:

- a. Cut an 8 or 9 inch circle out of the red paper (again you can use a paper plate) fold and cut it in half. These halves will be your wings.
- 4. Glue the head to the rest of the body.
- 5. Cut out the feelings wheel and glue to the black paper (the body of the ladybug).
- 6. Add the wings (red paper) using the short pieces of the pipe cleaner. If you have brass fasteners at home you can switch this out later.
- 7. You've made a ladybug! Now, draw pictures OR find pictures to cut out of magazines to show what makes you grouchy, happy, sad, and excited!
